PIUS is a friendly boy who laughs a lot. When he meets Peter, he starts laughing and jumping for joy. He is the first born in a family of 4 children. His sister Winny is severe disabled and also in our programme. The family lives in a timber house with pipewater and a pit latrine on the premises. It is a big burden for the mother to have two disabled children, so she works as a care-taker in the kitchen of Almasi Children Village and earns money.

When PIUS was 4 years old he got malaria which led to epilepsy. He has serious fits approximately every two days, mostly during the night. The seizures take very long, up to two hours. PIUS has a permanent ear infection, also since the malaria-sickness, with bleeding ears. He went many times to the Hospital for treatment. His ADL-activities are normal.

He went to Nursery and Mwangaza Primary School until class 3. When we tested him, he could not reach the level of class 1.

Provisional Rehabilitation Plan:

PIUS needs to attend the Special Education Class to learn to read and write his name and some basic mathematics. Creative therapy and sports.

The long term goal is that he will follow the VTC when he is older to learn some professional skills.
